

Exeter International Airport SAFETY POLICY- EMPLOYEES

Exeter and Devon Airport Limited recognises and accepts its responsibilities as an employer to provide, so far as is reasonably practicable, a safe working environment for all of its employees and to ensure their safety whilst on Exeter International Airport premises.

The Company will meet the responsibility, so far as is reasonably practicable, by the provision and maintenance of the following:

- Safe plant, equipment and systems of work.
- Safe arrangements for the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances.
- Sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to enable all employees to contribute positively to safety and health at work.
- A safe place of work and safe access to and from it.
- A healthy working environment.
- Effective arrangements for joint consultation on safety matters.
- Regular monitoring and review
